The Gospel quotes this lament, as a prophecy fulfilled when so many Jewish boys were slaughtered by Herod. But Jeremiah's word for the exiled people of his time promised a return from what was not death but merely separation.

The life of faith has its strange paradoxes, as Paul knew well. In all the intimidation of worldly power, God chooses the weak to show his true power working to bring down tyranny and save his people.
