This reading has a gloomy theme, as the writer describes all human endeavour as futile, ending in death for everyone. It undergirds Jesus' teaching about the futility of concentrating on worldly success and acquiring material things.

As we have heard these past three Sundays, this letter uses rich language to teach the unique riches of life in Christ, as Paul strives to recall this church from its dangerous fragmentation. Their conduct as Christians, he now says, must be quite different from that of their previous lives.

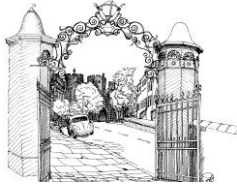


Alnwick International Music Festival. **OUR STALL IN THE MARKET PLACE** during this week is
