This reading and the Gospel illustrate different ways God calls people to his service. Isaiah was at prayer in the Temple and overcome by the awesome holiness of God. With the vision came the promise of sin taken away.

2ND READING 1 Corinthians 15:1-11 **Reader: Dee Ramsay**
(Page 172 of the New Testament in the pew Bible)

We have been hearing over several weeks Paul's efforts to clarify his teaching. He turns now to the very heart of the Gospel: the fact that Jesus was raised from death and seen by many people. Paul's own apostleship stems from the appearance to him of the risen Christ.
